1. God's Mercy & Compassion (even to outsiders)

- Exodus 34:6 God is "merciful and gracious, slow to anger..." (quoted by Jonah in 4:2).
- Psalm 86:15 Echoes the same language of God's mercy.
- Isaiah 49:6 God's salvation is for all nations, not just Israel.
- Acts 10:34-35 Peter realizes God shows no partiality, connecting to Jonah's reluctance to preach to Nineveh.

Repentance and Forgiveness

- Ezekiel 18:21-23 God desires
 repentance, not the death of
 the wicked.
- Luke 15 (Prodigal Son) God's joy over repentance parallels Nineveh's repentance and Jonah's bitterness.
- 2 Peter 3:9 God is patient, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance.



JONAH 3

God's Sovereignty Over Creation

- Psalm 135:6-7 God controls the sea and storms (as seen in Jonah 1).
- Nahum 1:3-4 God's power over nature, also directed toward Nineveh.

God's Universal Mission

- Genesis 12:3 All nations will be blessed through Abraham foreshadowing the inclusion of people like the Ninevites.
- Revelation 7:9-10 Every tribe and nation worshiping God—God's mercy extends to all people.
