# **JONAH 1**

*& explore further the depths  
of God's Word below*

## **1. God's Mercy & Compassion (even to outsiders)**

- **Exodus 34:6** – *God is “merciful and gracious, slow to anger...” (quoted by Jonah in 4:2).*
- **Psalms 86:15** – *Echoes the same language of God's mercy.*
- **Isaiah 49:6** – *God's salvation is for all nations, not just Israel.*
- **Acts 10:34-35** – *Peter realizes God shows no partiality, connecting to Jonah's reluctance to preach to Nineveh.*

# **JONAH 2**

*& explore further the depths  
of God's Word below*

## **Repentance and Forgiveness**

- **Ezekiel 18:21-23** – *God desires repentance, not the death of the wicked.*
- **Luke 15 (Prodigal Son)** – *God's joy over repentance parallels Nineveh's repentance and Jonah's bitterness.*
- **2 Peter 3:9** – *God is patient, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance.*

# **JONAH 3**

## **God's Sovereignty Over Creation**

- **Psalm 135:6-7** – *God controls the sea and storms (as seen in Jonah 1).*
- **Nahum 1:3-4** – *God's power over nature, also directed toward Nineveh.*

### **God's Universal Mission**

- **Genesis 12:3** – *All nations will be blessed through Abraham — foreshadowing the inclusion of people like the Ninevites.*
- **Revelation 7:9-10** – *Every tribe and nation worshiping God—God's mercy extends to all people.*
